



# Hatton (Cruden) Snow Day Activities



## P1/2 Class

Here are some suggested activities to do whilst you are at home during any snow days this session. You do not have to complete all the activities each day. Please share any activities when you are back in school.

Build a snowman and measure it using your hands or natural objects (sticks, pine cones etc).	Write your name, sounds, letters, spelling words and numbers in the snow.	Ask an adult to help you read some stories with you. Choose your favourite book and bring it in to share with the class.	Do a black pen drawing and ask an adult to help you write about the picture.
Play board games and card games.	Go on a number hunt. You can do it in your house or in the village. Draw or take pictures of the numbers you find.	Practise your phonics and tricky words.	Practise writing sounds that you know. Think of words which begin with these sounds and draw a picture for each word (s – snowman, h -hat).
Draw a picture of your favourite toy. Try to include lots of detail.	Make some soup or bake with an adult. Help to weigh out the ingredients.	Go sledging with family or friends. Make predictions about speed and distance of different sledges.	How many snowballs can you make in 1 minute? Get an adult to time you.
Build a snow sculpture. Draw a picture or take a photograph.	Draw a picture of yourself in warm clothes. Add some labels.	Log onto Sumdog and practise your maths skills.	Design a new pair of wellingtons.
Help with chores around the house (e.g. make your bed).	Build a den and then cosy up in it to read your favourite book.	Practise writing your numbers. See how far you can go!
