Here are some suggested activities to do whilst you are at home during any snow days this session. You do not have to complete all the activities each day. Please share any activities when you are back in school.

| Build a snowman measuring less than 50cm tall and with a girth of about 1 metre. | Make 3D shapes from the snow and build a snow robot. How many different shapes have you used? | Make a paper snowflake. | Practise your times tables. How fast can you say them all? Try to improve your speed and accuracy. |
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| Look out your window and create a detailed drawing of what you see. | Compare weather forecasts using <u>http://www.bbc.co.</u> <u>uk/weather/</u> or <u>www.metoffice.gov.</u> <u>uk</u> | Re-write the lyrics to 'The 12 days of Christmas' to make a modern version of the gifts. Eg On the first day of Christmas my granny gave to me a brand new Nintendo Wii. | Find a healthy recipe (e.g. soup). Make it and then write your own set of instructions. |
| Choose your favourite song now and create a dance routine that you could teach to the class. Revisit spelling words you have covered so far. | Make up a circuit of activities you could do in the snow. Practise your rapid recall of maths facts such as doubles, halves, times tables. | Go out for a walk in the snow and enjoy the fresh air. What animals can you see? Play board games with the family. | List as many adjectives (describing words) as you can to describe the snow and weather. Watch an episode of Newsround and record what you have learned from it. |
