



## Your Child's Learning Profile

Your child's Profile is where they document their individual development, learning and wellbeing. This is a folder that contains relevant assessments on their progress, reflections on learning, conversations to support target setting and next steps, and key information about them that they input and that you provide. The Profile is owned by your child and includes:

- All About Me information that your child identifies is important about them.
- Learning Targets a record of the discussions that we have with your child to support them to identify their strengths and next steps in an area of learning.
- High Quality Assessments evidence of learning across the curriculum through our use of assessments.

You are encouraged to engage with your child's Profile when visiting your child's learning spaces throughout the year to support your child's progress.

We have two opportunities for Pupil Progress Discussions/ Parents' Evenings throughout the year. One of these will take place prior to the October break, and one in March. This will give you the opportunity to discuss your child's progress and report and consider how we can work together to support their development, learning and wellbeing.

We will also provide you with a formal report twice a year, sharing the CfE Levels that your child is working at and comments on your child's personal qualities and wider learning this year.

These approaches to sharing your child's learning are designed to build positive working partnerships, as we value the key role that you have as your child's primary caregiver.

## Sharing Your Child's Learning

As well as using Google Classroom to communicate information with you, this will also be used to share learning highlights. Your child will begin to use Google Classroom and Google Drive to record learning digitally.

**Pupil Profiling** – your child regularly reflects on their learning throughout the year, identifying significant learning milestones and the progress that they are making. Your child chooses evidence of their learning as a learning highlight that they are proud of to add to their Profile on Google Classroom and Google Drive Folder.

**Wider Achievements** – these include achievements both within and out of school. Throughout the year your child will add to their wider achievements folder, and we will ask them to share what they are proud of. Examples may be: trying something new, participating in a club or sport, entering a competition, raising money for charity, volunteering in the community etc. The National Parent Forum for Scotland have <u>a helpful guide for families</u> with further information on wider achievement.

Throughout the year, there may also be opportunities for you to visit your child's learning spaces, to develop your understanding of the learning environment within our school.
