#### **Adverse weather**

Please keep an eye on the Aberdeenshire message service on the website (https://online.aberdeenshire.gov.uk/Apps/Schools-Closures/) for updates as your first port of call. This is detailed in the adverse weather letter. Safety of staff and children is paramount when making decisions on transport and school closure. The school will update you as soon as we get any information so, please be patient. Keep an eye on local weather updates as any ice, flooding or snow could impact on if and how children and staff get to school. Thank you.

### Winter clothing

The weather is turning colder and as ever, is very unpredictable! Please make sure your child has a suitable coat and any accessories for the weather (hat, scarf, gloves etc) and that these have your child's name clearly marked so that if any go astray, we can get them back to you.
