P5.6 Community Café

Our P5.6 class are hosting a Community Café event on the **Friday 22nd March 2024** from 2pm – 3pm. This is an Enterprise project for the pupils at the end of their topic exploring Climate Change. Pupils have been learning about sustainable, healthy living and Fairtrade. As part of the event, they will be developing their skills for life, learning and work as they will take on leadership roles in the planning and organising of the event, developing time management, money handling and communication skills.

The event will also provide an opportunity to fundraise for the school, towards the purchase of CleverTouch devices, which will enhance learning opportunities that we are able to provide our learners with. This will be a ticketed event, with tickets being able to be purchased in advance, as well as at the door on the day of the event. The cost of a ticket will be £2 and will include tea/coffee and a fine piece/buttery/pancake/scone. Children are free of charge.

There will also be raffles, a tombola and a lucky dip. Pupils will have elements of their learning on display to share with you throughout the duration of the event and will be presenting some of their learning.
